# Health Insurance?

If you think you may qualify financially for pregnancy Medicaid, the Florida Department of Health in Leon and Wakulla Counties can process your temporary Medicaid.

## **GET TEMPORARY PREGNANCY MEDICAID (PEPW) TODAY!**

Full pregnancy Medicaid can take weeks to be approved. PEPW is temporary pregnancy Medicaid which allows you to receive early prenatal care while waiting to be approved for full pregnancy Medicaid.

You will still need to apply for full pregnancy Medicaid online:

## **LEON COUNTY**

1. To apply, call (850) 404-6416 to schedule an appointment.
2. Attend your appointment at the Health Department in Leon County at 1515 Old Bainbridge Road, Tallahassee, FL 32303.
3. Bring a photo ID and a pregnancy statement signed by a doctor or nurse to the appointment.
4. Call (850) 404-6416 or (850) 404-6403 if you have questions.

## **WAKULLA COUNTY**

1. Pick up a PEPW application from the Health Department in Wakulla County at 48 Oak Street, Crawfordville, FL 32327.
2. Complete the PEPW application and leave it with the Health Department in Wakulla County.
3. The application will be processed the same day it is received.
